What data do we collect?

The toolkit collects the following data:

- Personal identification information: Business name, email address, postcode of business, Resilience Score.
- It also collects data tied to the markers of resilience.

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide us with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Register online.
- Use the toolkit

How will we use your data?

We collect your data so that we can:

- Conduct research into larger trends that affect the creative industries in the UK

How do we store your data?

We will securely store your data in a Wordpress site database kept on a GDPR compliant UK based server.

We will keep your data unless you want us to delete it.

Marketing

This is a not for profit project therefore we will not contact you to market or endorse any products for sale in any shape or form.

What are your data protection rights?

We would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access - You have the right to request copies of your personal data.

The right to rectification - You have the right to request that we correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request that we complete information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure - You have the right to request that we erase your personal data.

The right to restrict processing - You have the right to request that we restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing - You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability - You have the right to request that we transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.

What are cookies?

Cookies are text files placed on your computer to collect standard Internet log information and visitor behavior information. When you visit the toolkit, we may collect information from you automatically through cookies or similar technology.

How do we use cookies?

This site only uses essential session cookies to track whether a user is logged in.

If you visit our login page, we will set a temporary cookie to determine if your browser accepts cookies. This cookie contains no personal data and is discarded when you close your browser.

When you log in, we will also set up several cookies to save your login information and your screen display choices. Login cookies last for two days, and screen options cookies last for a year. If you select "Remember Me", your login will persist for two weeks. If you log out of your account, the login cookies will be removed.

How to manage cookies

You can set your browser not to accept cookies, and there is lots of information online that tells you how to remove cookies from your browser – see link provided above. However, in a few cases, some of our website features may not function as a result.
